

Travelling to Cavtat, Dubrovnik

Arrival by plane www.airport-dubrovnik.hr

The Dubrovnik Airport is in Čilipi, only 5 km from Cavtat. For local transport to Cavtat, there is a taxi service available 24 hours a day.



Direct scheduled flights from the UK to Dubrovnik:

Arrival by bus



You can come to Cavtat by bus through Dubrovnik, which is only 18 km away. In addition to international lines, there are daily intercity lines to and from all major Croatian cities and towns.

For transport from Dubrovnik to Cavtat, use bus number 10, scheduled every 30 minutes.

You can come to Cavtat by ferry, through the Dubrovnik port, which is connected by ferry lines with other Croatian ports (Korčula, Split, Zadar, Rijeka), as well as with Italian ports.
